- Financially constrained plan

 - Long-Range Planning
 - Assists local governments in making transportation decisions
 - Participation
 - Local needs
 - Deficiencies and improvements
 - Recommendations are CONCEPTS
 - Not Fiscally Constrained
 - Multimodal Maps Adopted
 - Time-Frame




Why a CTP?

- Better integration of transportation planning with land use planning
- Minimization of impacts to the natural and human environment
- Stronger ties to local priorities
- Reduced costs associated with right-of-way and construction activities

Onslow County Growth Rate

- The State of North Carolina as a whole is growing at 0.9% annually
- Currently, Onslow County's population is 187,589 (as of July 1, 2014 according to OSBM)
- According to the Office of State Budget and Management, Onslow County is growing at 1.4% annually
- The Growth Rate the Jacksonville Model used and the Jacksonville Long Range Transportation Plan shows is 1.4% annually for the entire county
- Is 1.4% an acceptable growth rate to use in the Onslow County CTP?
